

RACIAL DISCRIMINATION

In the last year, how many people did experience racial/ethnic or religious discrimination?

7.7% of people in BE felt they had been discriminated or harassed for their ethnic origin (5%) and/or religion (3.6%)

A club refuses entry to young Roma people; An applicant not chosen by a company because not European; a Moroccan woman is harassed because of her headscarf; A rental advertisement states "no blacks".

What does Globe Aroma do?

Hi5! is a cultural and artistic festival

organized in a public space with five social housing clubs situated in *Rempart des Moines*, heart of the city of Brussels. The majority of the inhabitants of the area live below the poverty line and many of them never participate in cultural and artistic activities.

Hi5! encourages meetings between inhabitants, spreading music, dance and poetry also promoting migrants social inclusion
