**8 events have been carried out within this project:**

### Event 1 - Pescara (Italy)

Participation: The event involved 29 citizens, including 15 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) 2 participants from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium) 4 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 3 participants from the city of Katerini (Greece) 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden) 1 participant from the city of Wattrelos (France)

Location: The event took place in Pescara (Italy); Dates from 10/05/2017 to 11/05/2017

Short description: The aim of the event was to showcase the project and increase stakeholder interest in our project activities. During the first day of meeting, after the official greetings, all partners made their presentation introducing the organisations (background, activities, previous work, involvement in EU projects, aims, vision etc.), and the immigration situation in each Country.

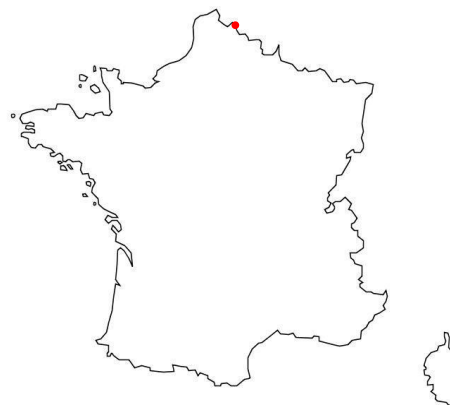


## Event 2 - Wattlelos (France)

Participation: The event involved 41 citizens, including 21 participants from the city of Wattlelos (France), 6 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden), 5 participants from the city of Durres (Albania), 2 participants from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium), 4 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia), 1 participant from the city of Katerini (Greece)

Location: The event took place in Wattlelos (France), Dates from 12/07/2017 to 13/07/2017

Short description: The aim of the event was to have a session about the “National citizenship in partner Countries” (legal issues, social rights), presented by each partner. By the French partner was presented a very interested project lead by local young people and then also a video projection created by ActiJean association: it was also an opportunity to interview young generations about migration, social inclusion, European citizenship.

### Event 3 - Glavić (Croatia)

Participation: The event involved 43 citizens, including 26 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia), 1 participant from the city of Katerini (Greece) 3 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France) 7 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy) 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden) 3 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) 1 participant from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium)

Location: The event took place in Glavić, (Croatia), Dates from 24/10/2017 to 25/10/2017

Short description: The aim of the event was to discuss about good practices carried out by local administrations in order to improve migrants' access to public services, integration and intercultural dialogue; eventual tools to reduce discrimination.



#### Event 4 - Rome (Italy)

Participation: The event involved 55 citizens, including 41 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) Belgium participants from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium) 4 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 3 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France) 1 participant from the city of Katerini (Greece) 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden)

Location: The event took place in Rome (Italy); Dates from 10/01/2018 to 11/01/2018

Short description: The theme of the two days was focused on issues related to reception in Italy; case studies of reception were presented by the Municipalities; the guidelines of the Italian Government on the reception of migrants were presented.



### Event 5 - Katerini (Greece)

Participation: The event involved 50 citizens, including 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden), 4 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 1 participant from the city of Bruxelles(Belgium)5 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy) 4 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) 3 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France) 31 participants from the city of Katerini (Greece)

Location: The event took place in Katerini (Greece), Dates from 19/04/2018 to 20/04/2018

Short description: The aim of the two days was to deepen the theme of the national policies of Greece at the reception level and that of integration and inclusion policies. On the second day it was possible to visit a reception center (Immigration Center of Kato Milia Hospitality Settlement), accompanied by representatives of local associations and the Municipality of Katerini.

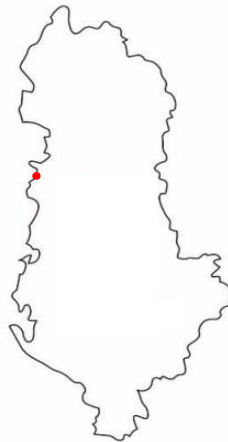


## Event 6 - Durres (Albania)

Participation: The event involved 76 citizens, including 57 participants from the city of Durres (Albania), 1 participant from the city of Norrköping (Sweden) 5 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France) 6 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy) 3 participants from the city of Katerini (Greece) 3 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 1 participant from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium)

Location: The event took place in Durres (Albania); Dates from 05/06/2018 to 06/06/2018

Short description: The meeting took place at the "Aleksandër Moisiu" University, thus giving the opportunity for many students to participate directly in the event, Albania, as a newly emigrated land, is facing the theme of the return of the second generations In the meeting it was the theme of the second generation and the theme of the Survey conducted by the Partners on "feeling European citizen." During the two days a short guided tour was organized between the remains of the Roman Amphitheater in Durres.



## Event 7 - Norrköping (Sweden)

Participation: The event involved 52 citizens, including 32 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden), 4 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 1 participant from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium) 7 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy) 3 participants from the city of Katerini (Greece) 3 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) 2 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France)

Location: The event took place in Norrköping (Sweden); Dates from 12/09/2018 to 13/09/2018

Short description: The aim of the meeting was to deepen into the main politics in this territory. First of all, were presented the Best practices and pilot projects developed in the region of Östergötland and the models and strategies for integration in Östergötland. Moreover, was presented an overview of the strategies for integration in the Municipality of Norrköping. An interesting session was about the development and changes of citizenship ideals, in the advanced liberal society of today, in the age of international migration, lead by Magnus Dahlstedt, Professor at Linköping University. All the group had the possibility to visit the cultural center of Hulstbruk.





## Event 8 - Bruxelles (Belgium)

Participation: The event involved 47 citizens, including 14 participants from the city of Bruxelles (Belgium), 2 participants from the city of Norrköping (Sweden) 2 participants from the cities of Breznički Hum and Gornja Rijeka (Croatia) 17 participants from the city of Pescara (Italy) 3 participants from the city of Durres (Albania) 4 participants from the city of Wattrelos (France) 3 participants from the city of Katerini (Greece)

Location: The event took place in Bruxelles (Belgium); Dates from 20/11/2018 to 21/11/2018

Short description: The purpose of the event was to discuss EU policies on migration issues; the meeting took place at the headquarters of the Abruzzo Region in Brussels. Subsequently, at the European Parliament, a meeting was held with some members of the European Parliament, such as Silvia Costa, to whom the content of the manual produced by the project partnership was presented. The REACT working group took part in the event for the celebration of the 70th Anniversary on the declaration of human rights. A large delegation of young representatives of the institutions of Abruzzo participated in the final meeting.
